

## ST BARNABAS AND ST PHILIP'S COFE PRIMARY SCHOOL

The average total points score, for your school, in all GLD goals is **23.2** out of a possible 24.






Your school's EYFSP good level of development has **increased by 2.0%** from **76.9%** in 2022/23 to **78.9%** in 2023/24.

## **COMPARISON | NATIONAL**



**78.9%** achieved a good level of development in your school, **11.2% higher than** the National average of **67.7%**.

This is the equivalent of **2 more** pupils in your school achieving a good level of development compared to the National average.

Your school has been above the National average **2 times** in the last 3 academic year(s).

Your school's relative change for achieving a good level of development has **declined by 21.4%**, from **+22.9%** in 2022/23 to **+1.5%** in 2023/24 when compared to the National average.

While your school average for achieving a good level of development has **increased by 2.0%**, from **76.9%** in 2022/23 to **78.9%** in 2023/24, the National average **increased by 0.5%**, from **67.2%** in 2022/23 to **67.7%** in 2023/24.

## **RANK**
