



English Writing

We will explore the book '**The Lost Happy Endings**' and explore the skills of prediction and inference. We will produce poetry, non-fiction and narrative pieces of writing.



English Reading

Krindlekraxx by Phillip Ridley

We will be reading this book Autumn 2 to allow the pupils to understand the different aspects of reading comprehension. We will focus on skills such as summarising, clarifying, evaluating, inferring and predicting.

Science

Light

We will explore: Light and Dark, Transparent and Opaque Surfaces, Mirrors and Reflection, Investigating Shadows.

Mathematics

Multiplication and Division, Length and Perimeter

In Multiplication and Division, pupils will recap prior learning with multiples of 2, 5 and 10 and will then learn the 3, 4 and 8 times tables. In Length and Perimeter, pupils will explore measuring, equivalent lengths and comparing lengths.

Music

Ensemble Skills: Call & Response

Year 3 marks the beginning of students' development of ensemble skills. Pupils will learn to actively listen, respond, and cooperate with peers in a musical context.

Settlements

We will explore: Types of Settlements, Urban, Rural and Sub-urban Areas, Population Density, What do Settlements Need?

History

The Anglo Saxons

We will explore: Anglo Saxon England, The Scots and the Picts, Settlements, Culture and Religion, Who were the Vikings?, Viking Raids and Invasion

French

Musical Instruments

We will learn the basics of the French language including how to name instruments.

The Great Sphinx, The Bust of Nefertiti, Making papyrus. Ancient Egyptian gods

Computing

Sequencing Sounds

Pupils learn about programming sequencing using Scratch. They start with the basic concepts and are gradually introduced to more advanced elements, leading to a final project creating a flute representation.
