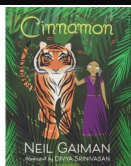




English Writing

Focus: survival, friendship and connection

Develop: extended answers for retrieval and inference questions, providing evidence and explanations.



Science

States of Matter

Children will explore solids, liquids, and gases, learning how materials change states through experiments like melting and evaporation. They will use equipment to investigate the properties of different materials, such as plastic, wood, and metal, focusing on magnetism, transparency, hardness, and electrical conductivity.

Religious Education

World Faith: Hinduism: How do Hindus worship?

Why do Hindus have many images of God? Why is the Aum symbol important to Hindus? How do Hindus worship at home? How does a Hindu priest help Hindus worship at the mandir? Why do Hindus go on pilgrimage?

Mathematics

Multiplication and Division

In Math, children will explore factor pairs and practice multiplying and dividing by 10 and 100. They will multiply 2-digit and 3-digit numbers by 1-digit numbers, and divide 2-digit and 3-digit numbers by 1-digit numbers. They will also solve correspondence problems and develop efficient multiplication strategies.

Build - Moving Miniature Playgrounds

We will be making a miniature playground which operates using a gear mechanism and electrical circuit for a KS1 child.

Geography

Eastern Europe

We will explore: Key Places in Eastern Europe, climate of Eastern Europe, physical Features of Eastern Europe, compare and contrast an Eastern European Country and conflict in Eastern Europe

History

Life in Ancient Rome

We will explore: Locating Ancient Rome, Monarchy, Republic, Empire: Rome's different governments, Pompeii, A day in the life of Ancient Rome, Latin: A Roman legacy

Music

We will be developing skills and learning how to read music, including reading notations, and understanding time. In our guitar lessons will we be developing the skills we have previously been taught.

Art

Design

We will explore: What is design in art?, examining design in Matisse's cut outs, examining design in The Scream— expressionism, examining design in The Scream—colour and making your own Scream!

Computing

Repetition in Shapes

Pupils will use Logo, a programming language, to create shapes and patterns. They will learn about repetition and loops, which are important concepts in programming.
